Sunday 1st March

- **HIGH RISK TRACKING CARD RUN: Cards In.**

- Lots of bush scrambling but Fence and Lake Edge are easier options.

Sunday 8th March – Taranaki Anniversary Weekend

NO FORMAL WORKING BEE: Line clearing in the bush or shifting new trap boxes up the fence if anyone is keen. A nice walk with some resistance training!

Sunday 15th March

- **WILLOW CONTROL or TRAP BOX UPGRADE**
