Sunday 9th January

- FENCE VEG TRIMMING** - Trimming back veg from beside the fence to keep this clear and protect the fence from windfalls

Sunday 16th January

- WILLOW CONTROL (if dry enough)** - Sweeping through the wetland fringe at the start of the eastern lake walkway, tidying up any small saplings
- FENCE VEG TRIMMING (if wetland is too wet still)** - Trimming back veg from beside the fence to keep this clear and protect the fence from windfalls

Sunday 23rd January

- TRACK WORK** – Carrying on with track work on the lake walkway, rebuilding some steps near the 2km marker and spreading metal

Sunday 30th January

- WILLOW CONTROL** - Sweeping through the wetland fringe at the start of the eastern lake walkway, tidying up any small saplings
