This is a summary of how Rotokare Scenic Reserve provides a safe learning environment.

- All visiting groups to Rotokare are given a short Health and Safety talk on arrival.
- As a place of employment, Rotokare Scenic Reserve Trust is required to be fully compliant with current occupational health and safety requirements and legislation.
- The buildings at Rotokare meet the South Taranaki District Council requirements for health, safety and hygiene.
- SAP and RAM forms and procedures have been developed in relation to the environmental education programme at Rotokare, and follow the education outside the classroom guidelines set by the Ministry of Education. These are available for inspection on request or on the Rotokare website.
- The onsite educator holds a current first aid certificates and carries a comprehensive first aid kit at all times, with a permanent kit situated in the operations room.
- There is no mobile phone reception at Rotokare; some telecom reception available at the office.
 The educator and all education volunteers carry radios for communication.
- There are alternative emergency exists out of the predator proof fence in the case of the main gates malfunctioning.
